

Sports Premium Funding 2015/2016

This financial year we expect to receive £9381 in sports premium funding.

This money will allow us to.

- 1) Re-join the Wolds Sports Partnership which gives us access to competitions, training, delivery of cycle safety training for children in year 5 and access to specialist advice.
- 2) Partially fund our full time, fully qualified, P.E teacher. Having a full time P.E teacher allows us to:
 - a. Have high quality teaching and learning in P.E, Games and Swimming from a teacher who has more skills, experience and training than most Primary teachers.
 - b. Allows us to run our after school provision which extends to around 20 clubs per week many of which are sports related.
 - c. Allows us to offer swimming on site. Nearly all of our children leave our school being able to swim at least 25 meters.
 - d. Allows us to compete in many competitions across the school year including cross country, football, netball, hockey, swimming, kwik cricket and rugby to name but a few.
