Thank you for all your hard work on the holiday homework. For Year 6, this is a very important term, as they build to the end of Key Stage 2 Assessments. The Year 5 children will be working hard to develop their skills across all areas and will have the chance to show how they will be great examples for next year.

As always, if you are available to help in school to listen to readers or have skills that fit any of the themes it would be good to hear from you.

# **English**

In English, we are placing a great focus on spelling and grammar skills. We are investigating spelling rules and have already found spellings that seem to defy a definite rule. Please help your child when learning new rules and practise the words that they bring home. Daily Guided Reading will develop the children's knowledge and understanding. We also have our pen licences to aim for.

### Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will continue to look at a range of problems. An area of great importance is the recall of basic number facts. Times tables and addition races our supported by the Mathletics website. If your child can access these at home please ensure they complete the weekly tasks. If not we can offer time during lunchtimes at school. We will continue to develop our skills with mental and written calculations. Please practise times tables with your child. These connect to so many areas.

### Science

In Science, we are learning about Forces. This will be great for the children to use their investigation skills. We will be finding out about gravity; air and water resistance; friction and levers. This links with our IPC topic very well.

### R.E

We will be considering how Christians' faith impacts on their everyday life.

### Computing

In Computing, we will be learning to develop our web designing skills, blogging and model manipulation through a 3D graphic program.

### **PSHE**

In PSHE we are studying Changes and Relationships.

### P.E

In P.E we will be focussing on Tennis and Swimming.

### Music

In Music we will be looking at composing through our theme 'Music at the Movies'.

# **International Primary Curriculum**

We learn these subjects through our theme. For our themes we have an entry day to enthuse the children and an exit day to celebrate all that we have learned.

- Finding out about 'dadaism' and creating a piece of art in the dadaist style.
