Dear Parent/Carer,

This year we have once again provided a multitude of sports and activities, at Market Rasen Primary School. Pupils have shared in success both within clubs and in outside tournaments. We have also been able to provide a Golf and a Dance club free of charge! Throughout the year I have seen many children try new clubs and gain in terms of their inter-personal skills and confidence. This goes to further reinforce the moral, cultural and spiritual ethos of our school.

As a continuation of the extra-curricular commitment that the staff here at Market Rasen Primary School show, we are now able to present to you the clubs that will be offered in the new term.

As before, with the governors' approval, a small charge has been agreed, the cost of which has been kept to a minimum as maximum participation is a key aim. The charge for these clubs will be **£1 per club per week**. However, if your child is entitled to free school meals, there is no charge for clubs.

Most of the clubs (where possible) will run after school, allowing the staff to run clubs that will contain quality teaching and learning time.

All clubs finish at 4.20. All children in clubs should be picked up from the Mill Road playground.

Should the need to cancel a club arise, you will receive a minimum of 24 hours notice. If it is not possible to give 24 hours notice due to unforeseen circumstances, additional staffing will be sourced. In the event of poor weather, all activities that are being run outside will be brought inside and alternative, but similar activities will be organised.

Attached are all the clubs that will be offered during the spring term. Places in some of the clubs are limited and will be awarded on a strictly first come first served basis. **Please return the completed form to the school office by Wednesday 18th April (payment is not required at this stage but will be requested later)**. Once places have been allocated, you will receive confirmation of the club(s) your child is able to attend and at this point payment will be requested. If payment is not received by the stated deadline, your child will not be able to attend the club(s).
