As you will know, we are fast approaching our residential trip to Rand Farm. Just a few final details so that you are aware of confirmed times, etc.

Children will need to be in school at normal time and will be taken to the hall for register and give any monies or medication to the adults.

**Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March** – Kestrels' class to Rand Farm Park for their residential visit. The coach will come to school to pick up Market Rasen children to leave school at approximately 9.30am. Children will need to be in school at normal time and will be taken to the hall for register and to give any monies or medication to the adults.

**Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March** – Harriers' class residential, Nettleton children and the day visit children to Rand Farm Park for their visit. Nettleton children will be picked up at school at 9.00am and the coach will then come to school to pick up Market Rasen children to leave school at approximately 9.30am. Children will need to be in school at normal time and will be taken to the hall for register and to give any monies or medication to the adults.

**Falcons' class** are due back to school at approximately **2.30pm on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March**. We will keep the children with us until 3.20pm as normal.

**Kestrels' class** and day children will return on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March at approximately 2.30pm**. We will keep the children with us until 3.20pm as normal.

**Harriers' class** will return on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March at approximately 2.30pm**. We will keep the children with us until 3.20pm as normal. Nettleton children will be due to arrive back at school for approximately **3.00pm on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March**.

### **Residential Kit List**

- (1) Enough clothes for the number of days of the visit. Please do not bring anything “new, favourite, designer or important” as it may become spoilt.
- (2) Pyjamas, (dressing gown and slippers recommended but optional)
- (3) Toiletries and towel for showers
- (4) Pair of Wellies (spares are available at Rand) in a separate bag – as these will be needed quite soon after arrival.
- (5) Pair of sensible shoes/trainers for visits to other sites
- (6) Sun hat and sunscreen (if the weather is hot)
- (7) Lightweight raincoat
- (8) Hat and gloves (if the trip is in cooler weather)
- (9) “Teddy” is welcome if you can’t sleep without him

Any medications should be name labelled and handed to the teacher.

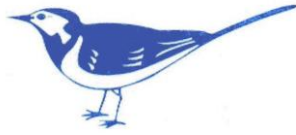
No mobile phones, computer consoles, etc to be taken on the trip.
