If you are able to help with other classes in addition to your child's, all help is greatly appreciated. Please let the school office or Mr Toothill know which classes you are able to assist with.

If your child is ill with sickness or diarrhoea they will be unable to swim for 14 days after the last bout of illness. Please make sure the office know the reason for your child's absence so our health and safety pool policy can be adhered to. **Please note that for health & safety reasons, all earrings must be removed for swimming.** If your child is unable to remove his/her own earrings, please ensure they are removed before coming to school that day.
