Dear Parent/Carer,

This term we have witnessed a fantastic period of achievement here at Market Rasen Primary School. Pupils have shared in success both within clubs and in outside tournaments. What is also brilliant to see is that the number of children involved in clubs is increasing, which shows how much the children are enjoying the clubs and are trying new things. Throughout the year I have seen children try new clubs and gain in terms of their inter-personal skills and their personal skills set, this is fantastic to see and highlights the amazing attitude to learning and discovery that the children at our school possess. Seeing all the children attending clubs this last term and witnessing their successes and progressions has been brilliant and I am sure that now, as we come into the summer term that these successes will continue.

As a continuation of the extra-curricular commitment that the staff here at Market Rasen Primary School show, we are now able to present to you the clubs that will be offered in the new term.

As before, with the governors' approval, a small charge has been agreed, the cost of which has been kept to a minimum as maximum participation is a key aim. The charge for these clubs will be **£1 per club per week**. However, if your child is entitled to free school meals, there is no charge for clubs.

Most of the clubs (where possible) will run after school, this allows the staff to run clubs that will contain quality teaching and learning time. Clubs will run weekly and will start **week commencing Monday 27th April**. They will run for 4 weeks up to half term and for 6 weeks after half term **week commencing Monday 1st June**. Should the need to cancel a club arise, you will receive a minimum of 24 hours notice. If it is not possible to give 24 hours notice due to unforeseen circumstances, additional staffing will be sourced. In the event of poor weather, all activities that are being run outside will be brought inside and alternative, but similar activities will be organised.

Overleaf are all the clubs that will be offered during this summer term, the day each club will be run on and the member of staff taking the club. Please put your child's name at the top of the sheet and tick the box of the activity(ies) that you wish your child to take part in. Places in some of the clubs are limited and will be awarded on a strictly first come first served basis. **Please return the completed form to the school office by Monday 20th April at the latest (payment is not required at this stage but will be requested later)**. Once places have been allocated, you will receive confirmation of the club(s) your child is able to attend and at this point payment will be requested. If payment is not received by the stated deadline, your child will not be able to attend the club(s).

I hope the above information answers any questions you might have.
