Dear Parents,

I hope that you had an enjoyable half term holiday and are looking forward to the final part of the school year as much as we are. This newsletter will give you some important information about the term ahead.

Y1 Phonics Screening Test

Children in Year One will undergo a phonics screening check between 16th and 20th June 2014. This check is to see how advanced children are in their use of phonics when reading real and non-real (pseudo) words. The outcome of this check will be included in your child's end of year report. Children who do not meet the required standard will be given extra help in Year Two.

Universal Infant Free School Meals

In September 2014, Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two will be given a hot free school meal so you will not need to provide a packed lunch unless you choose to. This will be an opt in service so in the near future we will send details home which will explain how to do an online order. We will continue to use The Farm Kitchen to supply our meals.

Lunchtime Supervisors Needed

Due to the introduction of Universal Infant free school meals we need two more lunchtime supervisors. We have included the job advert at the end of this letter if you, or someone you know, might be interested.

Mill Road Entrance
