Please can we remind you to make the payment for your child's swimming on Wisepay as soon as possible. We rely heavily on your donations to ensure we can meet the ever-increasing running costs of keeping our school swimming pool open.

Email communication

In the busy world we live in, we use email as a form of communication more and more. Please can I ask that any email correspondence for teachers is sent within school hours as much as possible as staff are encouraged not to respond to emails later in the evening. Any emails you do send will be responded to the next school day. If you need to communicate with school outside of school hours regarding an urgent matter, please email myself directly.

Staff will be available to speak to on the playground from 8.35am each morning and after school when they are dismissing their class. If you would like to make an appointment to speak to your child's class teacher, please do so through the office.

If you would like a sibling picture taking, please wait by the entrance to the hall on the main playground from 8.15am and the photographer will be happy to take these photographs for you. Please only do this if your child has a sibling that does not attend the school, any siblings in school will be automatically taken during the school day.

If your child has packed lunches, please make sure you follow the policy which has been written with pupil health and wellbeing in mind. Please remember nuts are not allowed in school due to allergies.

Hot lunches

Please remember to order your hot meal from the school kitchen via Wisepay by the preceding Monday each week. If you have any issues with Wisepay or if you don't have access to the internet, please speak to the office staff who will be happy to help you.


Could we also ask that you order meals with your child where possible so they know what you have ordered.
