London Residential September 2026

After a very successful trip in 2024 we are running the London Residential again for Year 5/6 children in September 2026. We will be taking the children for a 2 night, 3 day residential which has a jam packed itinerary! This will be an amazing opportunity for the children to learn about History, Geography and British values.

All Year 5 and 6 children at both Market Rasen and Nettleton will be invited to attend. A portion of Market Rasen children will accompany Nettleton for 2 nights with the remaining Market Rasen children attending for the other 2 nights.

The children will stay at the YHA, St Pauls Cathedral. We have secured sole use of a whole floor of the accommodation to ourselves for security. [Please follow this link to find out more about YHA St Pauls.](#) As ever, we will have good adult to child ratios to ensure children are safe.

Dates:

This is a 3 day and 2 night trip visit. There will be two identical trips:

- Monday 21st September – Wednesday 23rd September 2026
- Wednesday 23rd September –Friday 25th September 2026

Accommodation:

The children will be staying at the [St Pauls Youth Hostel](#).

Planned Itinerary:

- London Riverboat Cruise
- London Eye
- Tower Bridge Experience
- Tower Of London
- Private Open Top Bus Tour – Sightseeing attractions of London
- Tate Modern
- St Pauls Cathedral

Cost:

The cost for this trip is expected to be around £285 including accommodation, food and attraction entry costs. This cost also includes a wristband with contact details for security, and a brightly coloured cap the children will be required to wear for easy identification. This is based on the trip being at full allocation.

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Payment Stages:

- **By 30/11/2025- A non refundable £35 deposit must be paid to secure a space**
- 50% of the balance **must** be paid by 31st May 2026 (further £125.00) and the final (£125.00) balance by September 4th 2026
- Wisepay will also have set up a monthly instalment option of:

10 Monthly instalments : December 2025 -September 2026 of £25.00 per month

We have tried to make this as accessible as possible by communicating early to allow longer to pay which we hope will help with affordability.

Safety:

To ensure the children are safe on this visit we:

- Have secured exclusive use of the floor in which we will stay
- Children will wear a brightly coloured cap when outside the Youth Hostel.
- Children will have a wristband with contact details on.
- Children, staff and helper will be briefed in an age appropriate way about [run, hide, tell](#).

Booking:

Booking a place on this trip will be available on Wisepay from Monday 13th October 2025 and will close on Sunday 2nd November 2025.

We have strictly 100 spaces for a cohort of 124 so spaces are limited and strictly first come first served.

£35 non-refundable deposit will be needed when booking.

Once numbers are finalised and deposits received, we will set up the remaining balance on Wisepay to be paid as listed above.

If you have any further questions about the trip please contact the school. We hope that as many children as possible will be able to join us on this wonderful opportunity.
