Young Voices 2026

We have arranged to take a group of 50 Key Stage 2 children to Sheffield Arena to take part in Young Voices – The largest children’s choir in the World on Friday 30th January 2026.

The children will rehearse the songs in school with accompanying staff prior to the visit and then on the concert day, up to 9,000 children will rehearse together and then perform in an unforgettable evening performance. We have successfully taken part in this for the past two years and it has been an amazing experience.

We plan to travel by coach, leaving school at lunchtime and arriving in Sheffield in time for the practice rehearsals. The concert should finish by 8.30pm and we should be back on the bus by approximately 9pm. Depending on when we successfully leave the car park, this will decide on our ETA for home. We anticipate approximately 10.30pm to be back for children to be collected but will communicate this on the day.

The cost for each child will be **£28.50** and is inclusive of the coach, admission and a printed young voices t shirt. Places are limited at 50 and are strictly first come first served.
