Year 3/4 Residential trip to The Deep

We are delighted to have been able to plan another residential trip to The Deep and Humber area in April which will consist of two days with an overnight stay.

The residential visit will take place between **Monday 27th and Tuesday 28th April**. We will be visiting Normanby Hall Country Park and the Waters Edge as well as an exciting sleepover in the Aquarium!

The children will leave for the Humber area at the beginning of the school day and return by home time of the next day. Whilst on the residential, they will be involved in a variety of fun and educational activities linked to our topics which we know they will enjoy. The children will develop a range of skills including DT work on bridges and shelter building as well as developing the life skills that come with staying away from home. They will deepen their knowledge of our geography topic for the Spring term (Where we live in the UK) as well as learning about animals and their habitats from science.

The cost for the residential trip is £95.00, which will include transport, meals, accommodation and all the activities.

If you would like your child to attend, please pay a non-refundable deposit of £25.00 on Wisepay by 31st January, to secure a place.

We will then set the remaining balance up on your child's account so that you can pay this in 3 instalments (£23.33 per month) up until 30th April which we hope you will find beneficial.
