Year 6 Easter School

We would like your child to join us for our Year 6 Easter School from Monday 13th April until Thursday 16th April. The aim of the days is to prepare the children for their upcoming end of Key Stage 2 Assessments, commonly known as SATS, and to enhance their readiness for secondary school.

The days start at 9am and finish at 3pm. The children will work in small groups with the Year 5/6 staff in the morning, developing maths, reading, grammar and spelling skills. After a packed lunch, they will have a shorter afternoon session and then choose from a range of sporting, technological or artistic activities. The children do not need to wear school uniform throughout the four days.

On Thursday 16th April, as a reward for their participation in Easter School, we are planning to take the children for lunch at McDonald's in Cleethorpes and enjoy a film at the cinema. There is no charge for any of the activities as they are funded by the school. We will take the children to Cleethorpes by coach, setting off at approximately 11am and returning by 3pm. We will confirm the trip details nearer the time.
