Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 1 and 2 trip to Rand Farm Park: Wednesday 10th June 2026

The Martins, Merlins and Robins are planning a day trip to Rand Farm Park, on Wednesday 10th June 2026. We will also be joined by the Hawthorns from Nettleton. We have enjoyed learning about many different habitats and which animals live and thrive in these habitats. This will be a perfect opportunity for the children to be immersed in this topic further and explore the habitat of farm animals in a rural setting. They will have the opportunity for a tractor ride, animal handling and explore the animals that live in this habitat. The skills they will develop are the ability to make observations of the habitat the animals live in and think carefully about why the farm habitat is suited to the animals. They will be able to compare this habitat to other habitats they have been studying in the classroom.

We plan to leave school by coach at approximately 9.30am so please arrive at school at the usual time. We will then be back to school before 3.00pm, for the children to be picked up as usual.

The cost of the visit is £7.40 per child. We are very pleased to be able to offer this trip at a significantly lower price this year thanks to our Friends and Family Fundraising committee's tireless fundraising efforts throughout the year and their contribution towards class trips.

Payment can be made via Wisepay, using the same log in details as you use for ordering hot school meals. Once you have logged in, you will see a map/drawing pin emblem titled trips and visits, if you click on the emblem it will take you through to the trip details to make payment.

The children should wear school uniform for the trip but trainers or comfortable shoes will be best suited as the children will be active all day. The weather may be warm so your child will need a sunhat and sun cream, a water bottle and a waterproof jacket. We are planning to take a packed lunch with us to enjoy whilst we are there.
