### **Headteacher's Newsletter**

I hope that you and your child had a lovely half term holiday and are excited about this term and the run up to Christmas. This newsletter will give you some important information about this school term alongside some key dates for your diaries.

#### **School Budgets**

You will probably be aware from the media that school budgets are under pressure like we have never seen before. Unfunded increased staffing costs, energy costs and inflation affecting everything we buy has had a massive impact on our organisation. When the 2022/23 budget was set we held healthy surpluses for the next four years but these changes have meant all of that has now gone and we find ourselves, like many schools, in a deficit. Governors and I will do everything we can to ensure this doesn't have an impact on your child's education however inevitably there will be some things that will be affected.

There are small ways you can help us mitigate the impact on our budgets.

- 1) Making the voluntary contributions for trips, swimming, pantomime and clubs if you are able to do so. Historically we have always made up the shortfall from the school budget but that money is not now there. Payments can be made on the Wisepay link here.
- 2) Join our FAFF committee (more information about this below) where you can proactively help raise money that will enable us to continue with some of the things that may be lost.
- 3) Volunteering in school. We would love to have more volunteers to help children read in school, to help organise our library or tend our garden areas. If you feel you could support in any of these areas please contact me directly andrew.smith@marketrasen.lincs.sch.uk
- 4) Ordering hot meals from our School Kitchen if your child is in Reception or Key Stage One. The meals are free for you (saving around £400 a year) and supports the running of our kitchen. You can order meals from your Wisepay account here.

We fully appreciate that things are hard for many of our families and please know that your child will never be disadvantaged in any aspect of school life if you are not able to make payments.

#### **Food Support**

We are keenly aware that the economy is having an impact on families as much as on school. We are fortunate to continue to receive food from Tesco to distribute to families who need it.
