SPONSORED COLOUR RUN INFO & risk assessment Friday 23rd June 2023

We are holding a sponsored colour run at Market Rasen C of E Primary School.

This event is all about the children having fun to raise us some pennies! We want you to have so much fun and make it an event to remember! However we always have to identify the risks in activities and we ask that you read this carefully and sign a permissions form for your child before attending the colour run.

If you would like your child to take part in the Sponsored Colour Run - you MUST sign them up using the signing up form attached and sign the waiver - BY THE END OF MAY! You can also request to purchase safety/sunglasses when signing up. Please also read the risk assessment attached. You will then be sent a sponsorship form in due course to start collecting as many sponsors as you can!:)

FIRST AIDERS ON THE DAY: ALL STAFF at Market Rasen Primary School have paediatric first aid - and ALL STAFF at Market Rasen Pre School have paediatric first aid. A First aid station will be present and signposted on the school field; as well as access to fresh drinking water.

The colour run will be an after school event for all primary school children, so collect your child as normal and take them round to the field ready for the event. The event will start at 2.30pm for Market Rasen Pre-School children.

It will begin with a warm up - children will then be called up in year groups to take their place at the start line. Parents and spectators should then stay behind the enclosed area and cheer on your child/ren! Encourage your child to walk or run round the marked track on the primary school field, while staff & volunteers throw coloured powder at them! Children must be supervised by a parent/guardian before the run, and as soon as they have finished their run - you will then have the opportunity to purchase ice lollies for a small cost from the FAFF committee team.

All participants will receive a medal for taking part!

What to wear: Ensure your child is wearing clothes and footwear that you do not want them to get spoilt, as the colour may stain! For example, an old pair of shorts, trainers, and a WHITE t-shirt is fully recommended!

Mobile phones and photography - You can take photos at the event - please only take photos of your own child, if you have other children in the background, please do NOT post them on social media.
