Summer Term Reading Challenge 2023

Well done to everyone who participated in the Spring Term Reading Challenge.

It was great to see so much reading taking place at home and at school and the children enjoying their rewards at the end of the challenge.

As you know, being able to read is incredibly important as a life skill and hearing your child is vital in supporting this.

We are now launching our next reading challenge for this term. Our aim is for **all** of our children to complete the challenge!

Just to remind everyone - the challenge is:

Read at home four times a week, every week, between now and the end of the Summer Term. Week One starts during the half term holiday. (6 weeks in total) and you will be invited to a pool party with your class!

The rules are:

- You must read 4 times per week at home for at least 10 minutes. This can be your class reader, a home book, a comic, a magazine-anything really!
- Someone at home must sign your reading diary to say you have read each time. This might be a parent, grandparent, family friend or an older sibling.
- Your reading diary must be in school the week beginning the 10th July so we can see if you will receive an invite to the celebration.

Please can we remind you that your child's diary needs to be signed by an adult to support the reading they are doing. We are aware that lots of our older children read more independently but they still need your support with recording in their diary so they can attend the reward.

Please continue to encourage your child to take part and let me know if you have any questions.
