As part of our Romans topic, the Falcons, Harriers and Kestrels will be visiting Roman Lincoln on Friday 20th October. We will be walking around uphill Lincoln, following a map to visit the various Roman sites. We will also be visiting Lincoln Museum to see the Roman artefacts on display.

We will leave school at 9.15am and will leave Lincoln by 2.15pm in order to be back for the end of the school day. The children will need a packed lunch and drinks with them for the day. They need to wear school uniform and to bring a coat with them as we will be outside for most of the day.

For children who qualify for free school meals, Mr Scott is offering a choice of a ham or cheese sandwich; please select your choice below. **The deadline for ordering a packed lunch is TOMORROW, Thursday 12**th **October.**

After half term, we have a Roman soldier visiting us on Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th November. He will be leading sessions in drama, marching drill and explaining all about the weapons and equipment he uses.

We have put both costs together into one contribution. FAFF have very generously given us a donation which has meant we have been able to reduce the cost for each child by six pounds. This means the cost will be £5.80 per child for both the trip and the soldier visit.
