Reception trip to Hall Farm Park

The Finches are planning a day trip to Hall Farm Park, on Friday 18th July. We have enjoyed learning about many different animals, sea life and minibeasts this year. This will be a perfect opportunity for the children to be immersed in this topic further. We will have the opportunity to go on a tractor ride, walk goats and go on a woodland walk. Children will learn about what animals live on a farm, how to look after animals and the jobs that farmers do throughout the year. The skills they will develop are the ability to make observations of animals; thinking carefully about the similarities and differences between them and the environments. They will also continue to develop their listening and attention skills and the ability to build great relationships with others.

We plan to leave school by coach at approximately 9.30am so please arrive at school at the usual time. We will then be back to school before 3.00pm, for the children to be picked up as usual.

The cost of the visit plus the coach is £7.15 per child. We are very pleased to be able to offer this trip at a significantly lower price this year thanks to our Friends and Family Fundraising committee who have worked tirelessly throughout the year to be able to subsidise our coach costs for trips.

Payment can be made via Wisepay, using the same log in details as you use for ordering hot school meals. Once you have logged in, you will see a coach emblem titled trips and visits, if you click on the emblem it will take you through to the trip details to make payment. You can send cash/cheque to the office if you prefer.

The children will be able to come to school in non-uniform.

We are planning to take a packed lunch with us to enjoy whilst we are there in the café.
