Dear Parents/Carers,

To celebrate all of the amazing reading that is taking place at school and home, we are excited to be able to organise an Autumn Term Reading Challenge. Unfortunately, we were unable to hold our Pool Party Reading Challenge earlier in the year so we have decided to run a termly challenge across the year.

To motivate children to read more at home we are setting all children a challenge for the Autumn Term linked to our key value of commitment to achieve. The challenge is this:

Read at home four times a week, every week, between now and the end of the Autumn Term (6 weeks in total) and you will be invited to a special party with your class bubble!

The rules are:

- You must read 4 times per week at home for at least 10 minutes. This can be your class reader, a home book, a comic, a magazine-anything really!
- Someone at home must sign your reading diary to say you have read each time. This might be a parent, grandparent, family friend or an older sibling.
- Your reading diary must be in school on Friday 11th December so we can see if you will receive an invite to the celebration.

The celebration event will be in your child's class bubble. The children will be asked how we can make the celebration event as fun as possible for them.

We hope that all children will want to take part in the challenge. It would be lovely if all of our children could attend a celebration party!

We will also be looking at a class prize for the class who has the most children (and the adults) qualifying for the reading challenge.
