SUMMER TERM READING CHALLENGE

Dear Parents / Carers,

Well done to everyone who has participated in the Summer Term Reading Challenge so far. We are over half way now and only have four more weeks to go!

Just to remind everyone - the challenge is:

Read at home four times a week, every week, between now and the end of the Summer Term (10 weeks in total) and you will be invited to a special party with your class bubble!

The rules are:

- You must read 4 times per week at home for at least 10 minutes. This can be your class reader, a home book, a comic, a magazine-anything really!
- Someone at home must sign your reading diary to say you have read each time. This might be a parent, grandparent, family friend or an older sibling.
- Your reading diary must be in school on Monday 12th July so we can see if you will receive an invite to the celebration.

We are incredibly impressed with how many children are on track to join in the Reading Challenge reward.

Please can we remind you that your child's diary needs to be signed by an adult to support the reading they are doing. We are aware that lots of our older children read more independently but they still need your support with recording in their diary so they can attend the reward.
