

Will there be any costs?

No. The course is free and all resources are provided.

What about childcare? You may be eligible for childcare costs using our learner support fund. Please ask for details.

How will I learn?

The course is mostly Tutor/teacher led, with group, individual and paired work. The emphasis is on the work being fun. You will have a session with the tutor and working with your child each week.

How will my progress be recorded?

Your course targets, progress and achievements, along with photographs taken during the course, will be recorded in your Learning Diary which will be reviewed and updated throughout the course. Your Tutor will use your Learning Diary to assess your progress.

Will there be homework? If so, how much/how many hours?

No. However, learners will be encouraged to practise new ideas and activities at home. Home activity suggestions will be promoted for each topic to encourage parents to develop the skills gained in supporting their child's development through the course.
