- Borrowing eBooks, eAudiobooks and eMagazines through our online resources,
- Using the library computers (People's Network) which are internet accessible to get information either for homework or leisure activities. Please note that filtering software is in place.

If you would like your child to become a member of the library we need an adult to act as guarantor for any library member aged 17 and under.

To join your child to the library, please visit the library with a form of ID that shows your name and address e.g. a driving licence, utility bill or bank statement, to open a library account for your child.

Alternatively, you can join your child online via our catalogue: <https://bit.ly/LLJoinOnline> and your child will receive a temporary library membership and have instant access to our online collections of eBooks, eAudiobooks and magazines. Once you have joined your child online you can bring the temporary library card number and a form of ID with name and address into the library and we can very quickly convert your child's membership into a full membership with their own library card ready to borrow books on their class visit.
