Year Six SATs Week

As you are no doubt aware, the Year 6 children have their Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) coming up next week. The assessments start on Monday 9th May, ending Thursday 12th May. The timetable for the week is as follows:

Monday 9 th May	English Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation
Tuesday 10 th May	English Reading
Wednesday 11 th May	Maths Arithmetic and Reasoning Paper 1
Thursday 12 th May	Maths Reasoning Paper 2

The children are very familiar with the format of the week, as it is the same as our Assessment Week format for Year Six each half term. All tests are carried out during the morning sessions. They will be working in their usual rooms, with their usual group and the Year 5/6 staff.

We would like to invite the children to come in a little earlier so that they have the opportunity to settle into the day, from 8.30 am, each of the test day mornings. We have asked them what 'treats' would make it a little more enjoyable and they have asked for a range of breakfast items including toast, pain au chocolate, croissants and cereals!
